About the cover 封面说明:

B. Route to Building 1, Lee Shau Kee Humanities Building

- 1) Go north from Exit A of Peking University, East Gate station of Beijing Metro line 4 and enter Peking University through the East Side Gate (东侧门).
- 2) After you enter the East Side Gate, go straight (west) for about 200 meters. Turn right after you go past the meadow on your right.
- 3) Go north for about 400 meters and turn left as soon as you go past the soccer field on your left.
- 4) After about 75 meters, you should see a giant rock with the characters 李兆基人文学苑 (Lee Shau Kee Humanities Garden) written on it. Turn right and enter.
- 5) Building No. 1 of the Lee Shau Kee Humanities Garden is the building immediately on your left.



Directions To Conference Venues

北大东侧门至会场路线图

A. Route to Building 6, Lee Shau Kee Humanities Building

- 1) Go north from Exit A of Peking University, East Gate station of Beijing Metro line 4 and enter Peking University through the East Side Gate (东侧门).
- 2) After you enter the East Side Gate, go straight (west) to end of the road, where you should see a building on your right with the characters 'Yáogǎnlóu' (遥感楼) written on it.
- 3) Turn right and go north past the Bóyǎ Tower (on your right) and the Wèimíng Lake (on your left).
- 4) After you go past the Wèimíng Lake, continue north, and you should see a small pond to your right.
- 5) Turn right as soon as you go past the pond and enter the Lee Shau Kee Humanities Garden. Then turn left.
- 6) At the end of the path you should see on your right the Building of the Dept. of Chinese Language and Literature. The characters 'zhōngwén' (中文) were written on a plaque at the top of the gate of the building.



二、东侧门至李兆基人文学院 1 号楼

1. 从地铁 4 号线北京大学东门站 A 口向北约 50 米至东侧门进入学校。
2. 进入东侧门后向西直行约 200 米，经过右手边草坪后右转。
3. 向北直行约 400 米，在经过左手边足球场后左转。
4. 向西直行约 75 米后，看到右手边“李兆基人文学院”石头后右转进入。
5. 左手侧即李兆基人文学院 1 号楼



一、由东侧门至中文系(李兆基人文学院6号楼)

1. 从地铁4号线北京大学东门站A口向北约50米至东侧门进入学校。
2. 进入东侧门后向西直行至道路尽头，右手边的楼上有“遥感楼”字样。
3. 向右转，向北直行经过博雅塔（道路右侧）、未名湖（道路左侧）。
4. 沿未名湖东侧道路经过未名湖后，继续向北直行，道路右侧可见一小池塘。
5. 经过道路右侧小池塘后右转进入李兆基人文学院，直行约30米左转。
6. 至院内尽头右手边即中文系，楼上有“中文”字样牌匾。

Every presentation room at PKU comes furnished with a PC desktop computer dedicated the session.

As your presentation will be projected on the screen and simultaneously viewed via VooV, we highly recommend providing a PDF version of your PowerPoint. This will make things easier and more seamless for everyone. We also suggest using the conference's computer for your presentation to avoid any potential issues.

If you prefer using your own laptop, please ensure that it is logged into the VooV meeting for the venue.

We strongly encourage you to send your PDF file to ICSTLL-57 the day before your presentation. This way, we can have it ready on the conference computer for you, minimizing the risk of virus infections from USB drives.

By submitting your PDF in advance, we also have the option of offering real-time translation services (English to Chinese and vice versa). We could display your presentation on one side of the screen and show the translation of your speech on the other side, including the Q&A session. If you require this service, please notify us in advance by the end of October 22, as we need to estimate the hours needed for translation.

One last suggestion: please ensure that the font size in your presentation is no smaller than 24pt for readability. If you're using the translation service, a larger font size is recommended.
